 Operate in a closed system with the code: information/not information



Journalists' ethics?

- How to deal with stories on radiation risks that has no standard scientific guildelines.
- Journalists cannot bracket their values and commitments that guide their personal lives and beliefs in reporting on Fukushima
- Framing stories as conflicts between "calm scientists/authorities vs. hysteric mothers" is a too easy way in describing the situation.

→reporting on Fukushima requires more than value-free, truth-telling, objective model of journalism.



 In 2017, Journalist Shiori Ito came forward to the public and accused a prominent journalist Noriyuki Yamaguchi of rape.

 Yamaguchi, a US correspondent for the Tokyo Broadcasting System and a biographer of Japan's Prime Minister, Shinzo Abe, denied the charge.

"You were not wrong" "You did nothing wrong"




Sexual harassment and sexual assault including silencing victims is occurring everywhere in power relation structured in gendered way

Problems of Luhmann's "description"

Blanket description of "system"

- Drastic changes taking place in the media landscape
- Luhmann theory fails to capture uninstitutionalized emerging phenomena.
- It endorses past/present modern systems that are firmly established.
- It indirectly stands for the autonomous, rational, male- and European-centric human image.


- Code <information/not information> does not explain any of the most important problems and acute phenomena in the present digital media culture
- <information/not information> is decided outside the media system.
- The concept "structural coupling" is too vague to start any meaningful analyses.

Recent code examples

 authentic/not authentic instead of information/not information (-> Fake news)

 creative/ not creative instead of professional/not professional (internet memes of #MeToo, #DistractedlySexy) Tim Hunt, "Three things happen when they (women) are in the lab. You fall in love with them, they fall in love with you, and when you criticise them, they cry."

-> He resigned from the honorary post at UCL and damaged its reputation.
